How do I set a reading goal?

How do I keep track of the books that I read?

Just print out the reading log and write down the titles of the books as you read them. Print as many copies of the reading log as you need.

What kinds of books do I have to read?

You can find a list of great books on the Lake George website, go to the public library and check out books, trade books with friends, go to the book store, the list is endless. What do I do with my goal sheet and reading log when the summer is over?
